REPORTS

Might ask for some book room material to be conductive for active boys in the classroom. Summer plans needed for children as there may be some inconsistencies over the summer. New Physed instructor would like to get into archery.
- It's been a good year, excited for next year as most staff will be back next year.
- Library balance of \$359.75. Alissa made a motion and Danielle seconded a motion. Motion approved.
- Lunch balance not via PTO as families can get assistance through the district food service program.
- Junior achievement Costs \$500 per instruction/room. Trivia night fund raiser. Mr.
 Jeske will bring back more information. Danielle made a motion, Alissa seconded a \$500 donation. Would like to provide donation closer to the next trivia night fundraiser.

NEW BUSINESS
