
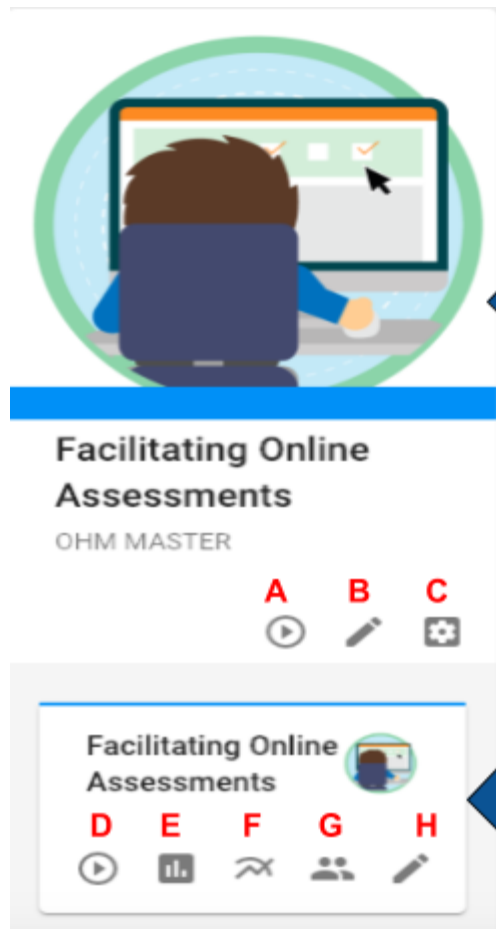

Note that in Buzz teachers may have a **Master Course** and then a **Derivative Copy of the Master** that students are placed into. The following will help teachers understand the various icons on course cards. Please note not all teachers will see a Master Course.



Master Course is first card


When teachers edit the Master course, those activities or changes will feed down into the individual teacher courses.



Individual teacher course is underneath the Master course.

This is where activities can be created and they will appear in the individual teacher copies of the course as well.	<b>Course Settings</b> for the Master Course	<b>Activity icon</b> for the individual teachers course	<b>Gradebook</b> This is where individual teachers can see student grades and grade activities.	<b>Reports icon</b>	<b>People</b> Teachers can see who is in their course and how they are doing	<b>Editor</b> for the individual teacher course. This is where activities can be created.



To add an activity to your course click the “+ **Add To**” either at the bottom of your editor OR click on the down hat of a folder and click “+ **Add To**” to add to the folder. Once “+ **Add To**” is clicked a window of activities will pop up.

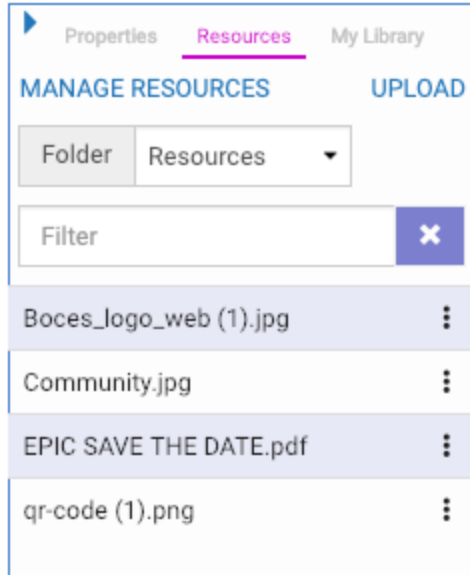
