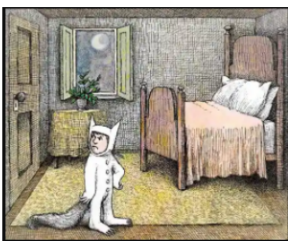

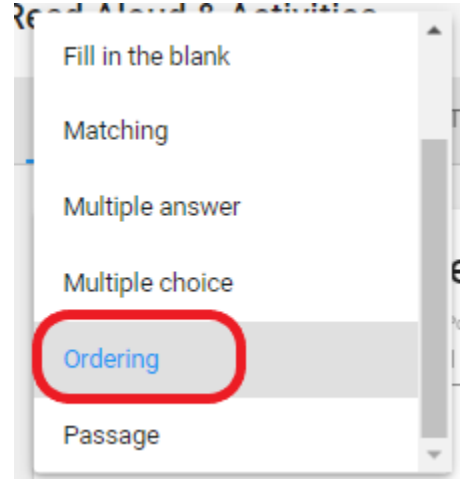

- A. **Choose assessment or practice questions** activity from the list of activities in your Buzz editor.
- B. In the **questions tab**, **click the + symbol** to the left of the screen and from the drop down menu choose **Ordering**.



- C. Scroll down to the **“Interaction” box**
- D. Under interaction choose **“Drag and drop”**. If you wish to have a horizontal orientation then also select **“Horizontal Orientation”**
