Course Goals

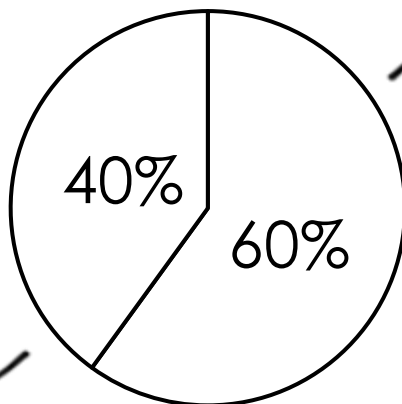


- Learn new vocabulary in Spanish

Assignments and Late Work

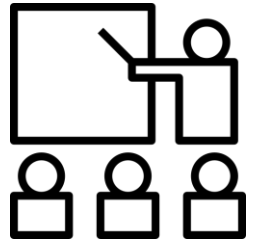
Technology Use
