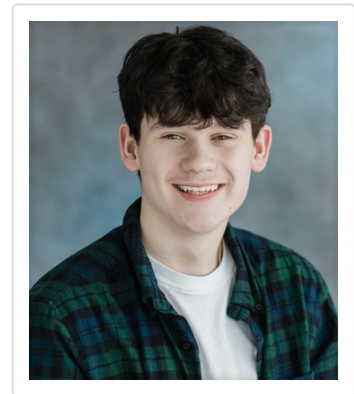
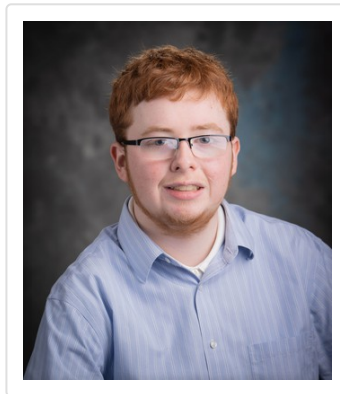
education has prepared students to be successful.

Alexander Bauer

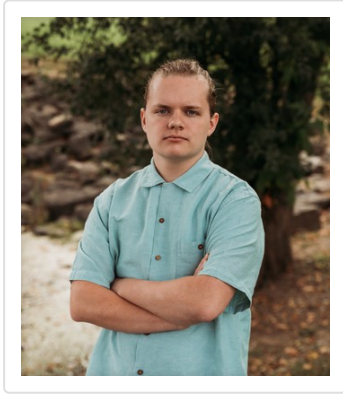
Alex is a 2022 Whitesboro graduate. He earned an associate degree in mechanical engineering technology and is transferring to SUNY Polytechnic Institute.

Cody is a 2021 Sauquoit Valley graduate. He earned an associate degree in electrical engineering technology. He plans to enter the workforce.



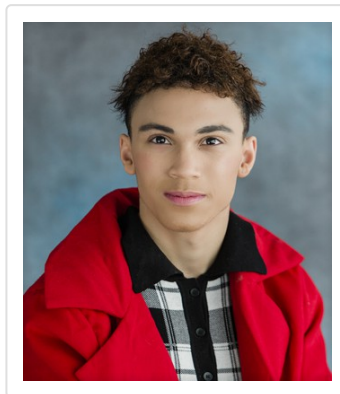
Braden James

Braden is a 2022 New Hartford graduate. He earned an associate degree in mechanical engineering technology and plans to enter the workforce.



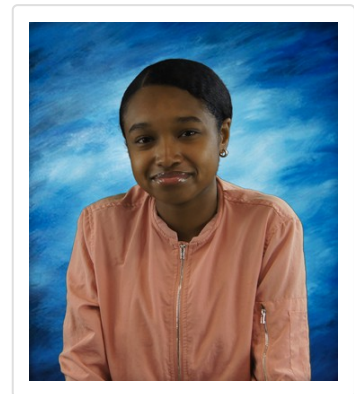
Austin Lowery

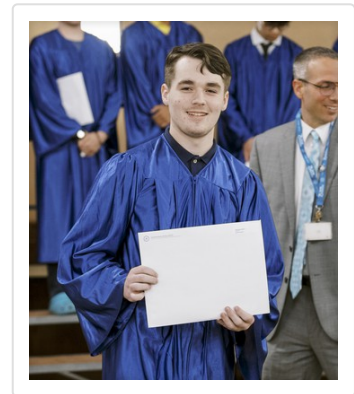
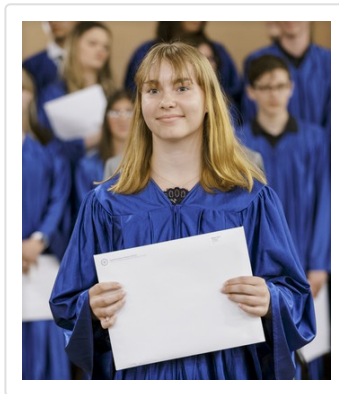
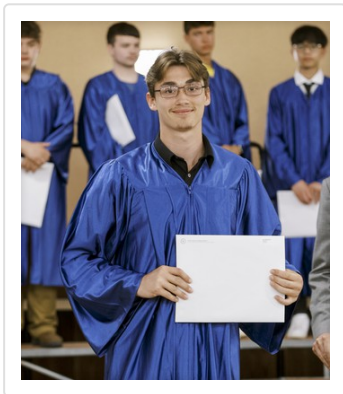

Bella is a 2022 Utica graduate. She earned an associate degree in human services and is transferring to SUNY Polytechnic Institute.

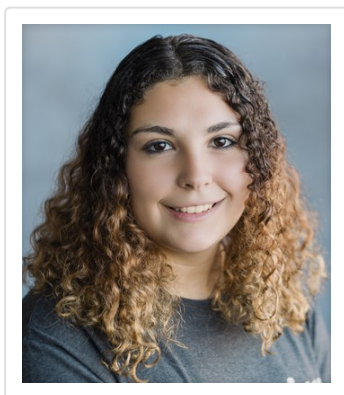
CTE Honor Society Induction

Student Ambassadors



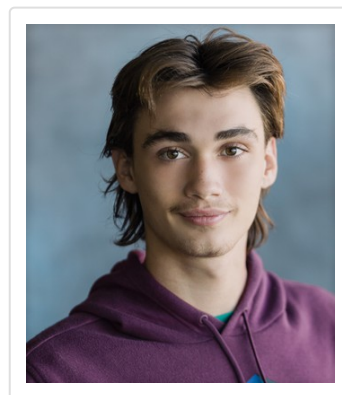
Freshman: Samantha Aldrich

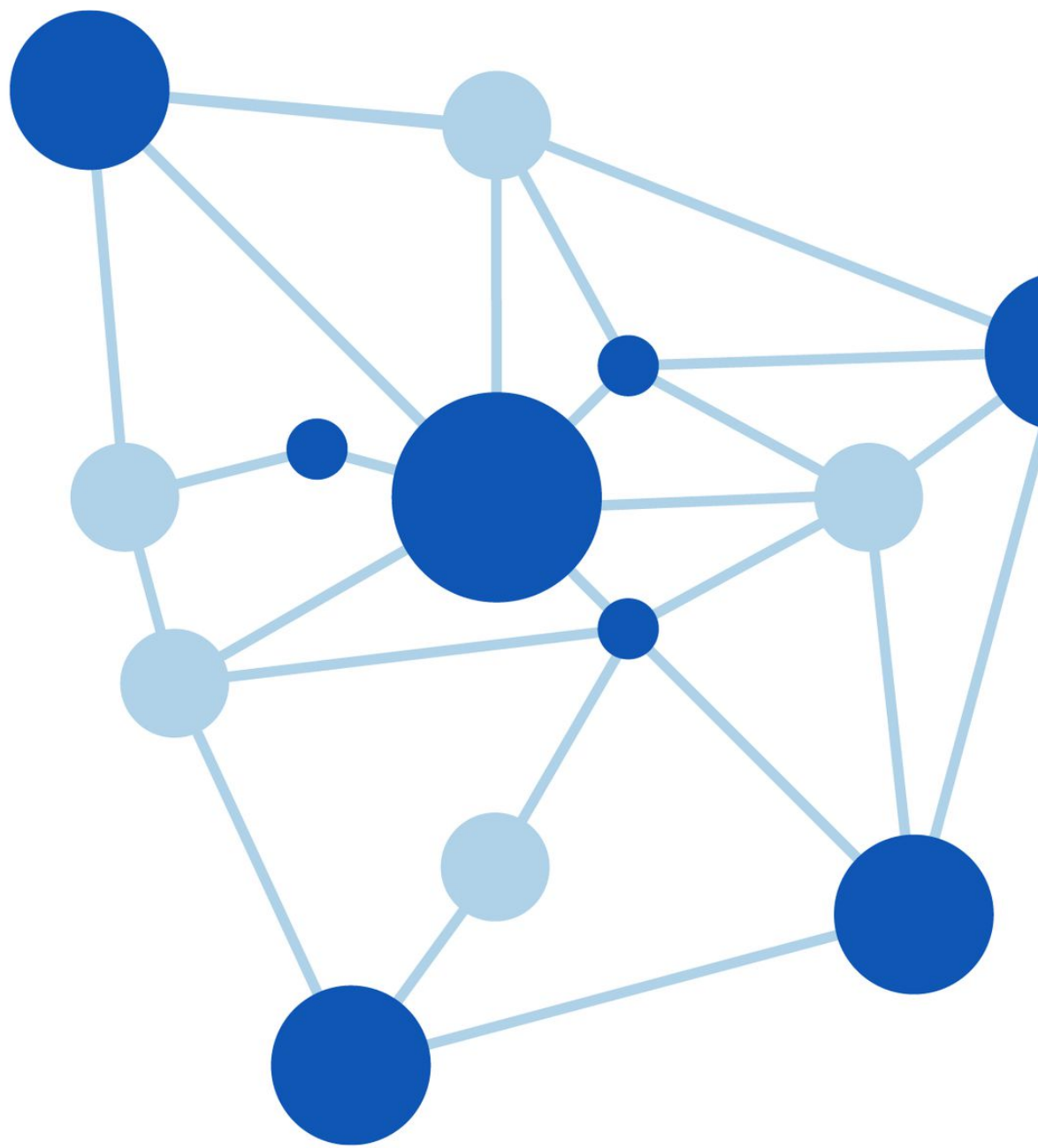
