Ms. Bond (Ms. Krehbiel) moved the Board authorize the purchase of Transeo Work-Based Learning Software to support student's college and career development in an amount not to exceed \$38,809.85.  The motion passed 7-0.
YMCA CDC Annual Contract	At Ms. Bond's request, Mr. Bielefeld explained the bid and contract process for this program.  Ms. Bond (Ms. Hedrick) moved the Board authorize payment to the Greater Wichita YMCA to operate child development centers at each of the comprehensive high schools beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023, for costs not covered by user fees in an amount not to exceed \$212,880 for the 2022-23 fiscal year.
