Executive Session #1: Non-elected personnel	<p>At 4:05 p.m., Ms. Hedrick (Ms. Logan) moved the Board recess into an executive session to discuss compensation for non-elected personnel pursuant to the non-elected personnel matter exception under the Kansas Open Meetings Act.</p> <p>The motion passed, 7-0.</p> <p>At 4:25 p.m., Board President Reeser reconvened the meeting.</p> <p>At 4:25 p.m., Mr. Reeser (Ms. Hedrick) moved to extend the executive session by 30 minutes.</p> <p>The motion passed 4-0, with Ms. Krehbiel, Mr. Reeser, Ms. Hedrick, and Ms. Stabler voting.</p>

Operations	<p>Superintendent Search</p> <p>Michael Collins and David Faltys of Ray & Associates briefed the Board on the priorities and goals of the superintendent search. Ray & Associates proposed a timeline of events for an internal search, followed by an external search if necessary. Ray & Associates will then work with designated district staff to implement the approved plan, seek community feedback, and ultimately develop the candidate profile that will be the foundation of the search for the next Wichita Public Schools superintendent.</p> <p>At approximately 5:10 p.m., Ms. Hedrick left the table.</p> <p>At approximately 5:15 p.m., Ms. Hedrick returned to the table.</p> <p>Ms. Logan (Ms. Hedrick) moved to adopt the timeline offered by Ray & Associates for internal and external candidates.</p> <p>The motion passed 7-0.</p> <p>Mr. Reeser (Ms. Hedrick) moved to advertise a base salary for the new superintendent between \$300,000 and \$325,000.</p> <p>The motion passed 7-0.</p>
