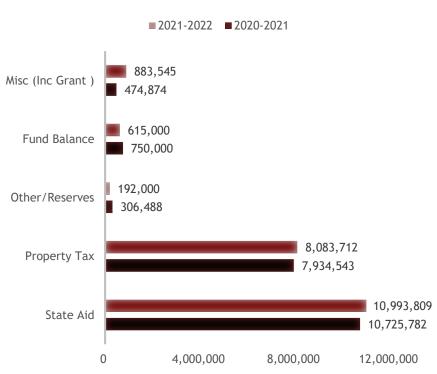


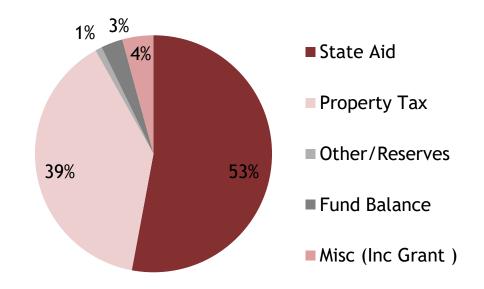

SOURCES OF REVENUE

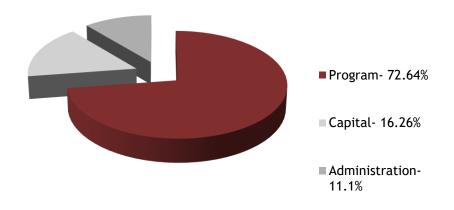

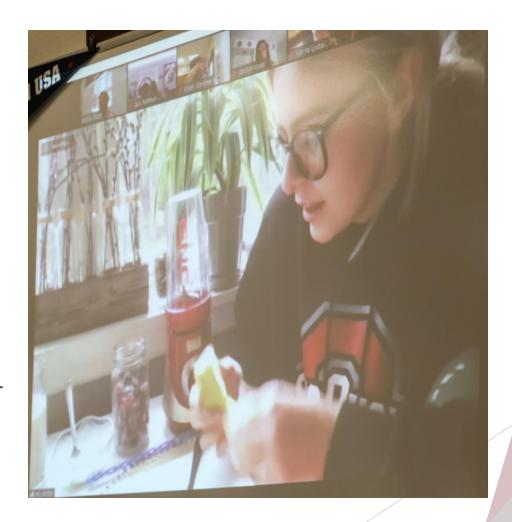

Efficiency Efforts to Reduce Costs

- ▶ BOCES Purchases:
 - Supplies, Itinerants, Summer School, Cooperative Bidding
 - ► Participation in Consortiums (Health & Natural Gas)
 - Participation in the CBO
 - ► Cafeteria Program
 - ► Computer Technicians
- Participation with Area Districts for Additional Sports Opportunities





Maintaining all current programs with no cuts, and adding the following:



- FT LMSW
- FT Occupational Therapist
- ► FT Elementary Special Education Teacher
- Increase in PT and Speech (through BOCES)
- ▶ FT Cleaner
- ▶ 3 Additional TA's
- ► FT Registered Nurse
- ► K-12 STEAM Initiative
- ► 6-12 Technology/Shop Teacher
- ► Grades 4-6 Band
- ► Elementary Summer Enrichment (PK-6)
- ► Additional Extracurricular Opportunities (6-12)
- ► After School Exploratory Enrichment Program



Proposed Tax Levy Impact

Proposed Tax Levy Impact per \$75,000 Assessed Home Value* Town & Village of Frankfort \$65.21 Town of Schuyler \$(67.10)

- NYS Tax Levy Allowable Limit is 1.08%
- Proposed tax levy is 1.88%
- Requires a Super Majority (60%+1)

Library Tax

- ► Library Resolution on this years ballot increases the library levy 2%
- ► Library Tax is <u>NOT</u> affiliated with the Frankfort-Schuyler Central School
- ► A library tax line item will continue to appear on property tax bills that are sent out in September.
- ► The school district is required, by law, to collect this tax on behalf of the library and forward appropriate amounts to the Frankfort-Free Library



What Happens if the Budget is Defeated?

- ► If the public votes the budget down- the BOE has three options
 - Put the same budget out for vote
 - Adjust the budget and put out for vote
 - ► Adopt a Contingency Budget (resulting in a reduction of \$149,169)
 - ► Under a Contingency Budget the tax levy must remain the same.

- Examples of Required Expenses
 - Expenses Authorized by NYSED
 - Contractual & Legal Obligations
 - Expenses to ensure the health and safety of students & staff
- Under Contingency Budget the following <u>must</u> be cut:
 - Equipment Purchases
 - New Capital Expenditures
 - ► Free Public Use of Building
- Under Contingency Budget the following <u>may</u> be cut
 - ► Athletics & Extracurricular Activities
 - Non Required Programs such as Elementary Art and Music, Project Lead the Way, EBD, AP and College now classes and other electives



2021-2022 Voting Regulations



- Eligible Voters are those that are
 - ▶ 18 years of age or older
 - Resident of the district for 30 days prior to the vote
 - ▶ United States Citizen

2021-2022 Proposed Budget

- ▶ 2021-2022 Budget
 - **\$20,768,066**
 - ▶ 2.85% or \$576,379 Increase
 - ► Tax Levy: 1.88%**
 - ► Tax Cap: 1.08%
 - ► Requires a Super Majority of 60%+1



** Five Year Tax Levy Average: 1.91%
