What is it?

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A progress report is a document provided to parents at the end of 1st, 2nd, and 3rd nine weeks that provides an update as to how well the student is progressing on their required standards.



A report card is a document provided to parents at the end of the year that provides the final status of the student's academic achievement for the year.

What is Standards Based Grading?

Standards Based Grading is a way for teachers to track your student's progress and achievements that is based on your student showing signs of mastery/understanding on the standards reported. Each progress report provides an update on their progress. Throughout the year, the student is able to improve on each standard. The report card, given at the end of the year, will show the student's final status on each reporting standard.

What does the grading scale mean?

- 4.0 Exceeding Expectations
- 3.0 Meeting Standards
- 2.0 Close to Meeting Standards
- 1.0 Not Yet
 - + Satisfactory
 - Needs Improvement



How can I check my student's progress in between reports?

Folders are sent home with student work and important information regarding academics and behavior. ClassDojo is used for communication between parents and the teacher. Student Led Conferences are available two times a year and parent conferences are available by request.
