Parent Expectations

- Provide lunch for children daily, unless advised about a special lunch provided by Trinity. Trinity will provide snacks.
- Provide sunscreen and a water bottle daily.
- Please list any allergies or special needs on the form provided.
- Arrive at camp before 9:00 a.m. We depart for most field trips between 9:00–9:30 a.m. If late, please contact Ms. Joy Campbell at 919-402-8262 or email her at <u>jcampbell@tsdch.org</u>.
- Parents are expected to pay for camp before the week the child starts. If payment is not received before each Monday, an email will be sent stating that the child cannot attend the next week.

Children Expectations

- Come every day with a positive mindset.
- Bring sunscreen, water bottle, and lunch daily.

Health, Safety, and Security Procedures

- If your child is sick (fever, stomach ache, infections, etc.), please keep the child at home.
- The school nurse will be on call during the summer. If medication should be administered, Ms. Campbell is trained to administer medicine to students.
- If your child is out from sickness all week, you will receive a refund for that week.
- Drop off your child at the modular before 9 a.m. Pick up your child by 3 p.m., unless you have signed up for Extended Care, in which case the latest pickup time is 5 p.m.
- When dropping off and picking up, please sign your child in and out on the available forms.
- You must be 16 years of age or older to sign a child out. No child will be released to anyone younger than age 16.
- Please expect to show proof of identity on your first day of picking up. If anyone new is picking up your child, please inform Ms. Joy, and they must show ID.
- There may be one fire drill during the summer to keep children aware of the fire drill procedures.
- John Foster, Trinity's Safety and Security Advisor, will be on campus all summer.
- There are security cameras on campus, and drills have been set in place to keep everyone safe in case of emergency.
