Ping-Pong is one of the most popular school activities in China, as well as in our GR school. Students from Chinese classes, clubs, other classes, and some faculties have been enjoying this sport. A school-wide Ping-Pong tournament has been a popular activity in the winter season.

Lily Yip is the Director & Head Coach of the center. She was the 2016 US Olympic Team Coach, US Team Member for 12+yrs., 2-time US Olympian [1992 & 1996]. The facility provides Pingpong training and culture introductions to the public. Ms. Yip also joined our Confucius Classroom opening ceremony in 2012.

But with all the exciting school activities surrounding this sport, the middle school Chinese classes never had a chance to participate. This will be their first time to visit the center. It will be a great opportunity for them to experience the sport and culture in a professional setting.
