**PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

Ms. Ginsburg welcomed families back to school. She shared that New Jersey is administering the Start Strong Assessment at the start of the school year. The assessment will be given to students at RAS and GRHS. Ms. Ginsburg reported that state mandatory weekly testing for non-vaccinated staff members was eliminated. She discussed the national teacher shortage and mentioned that recently the White House had a conference on the topic. Ms. Ginsberg summarized the Board of Education's Self-Evaluation.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Mr. Phillips also welcomed everyone back to school. He provided an update on the opening of schools and the summer work completed in preparation for the reopening of the buildings. Mr. Phillips thanked the 12-month staff and the teachers for setting a positive tone for the students during the first couple of school days. A list of the new staff members and the enrollment numbers in the schools was displayed. Mr. Phillips reviewed six areas the district will focus on during the school year: Elementary Literacy, DEI, Strategic Planning, Intervention Programs, School Safety, and Learning Environment. His presentation can be found on our website.
