 6. Write your chosen elective courses in the available spaces. All elective boxes must be filled in
 7. Return your elective sheet to your middle school teacher
- If you are interested in IB, be sure to turn in your on-line Honors application by. Declared freshman students must enroll in a world language (Spanish, German, or French), in a math course beyond Algebra I, and must be engaged in the embedded honors options in the core freshman courses of English, History, and Science. The honors application is located on www.southsaxons.com, click on the IB tab at the top.
 - Completing a World Language course is not a graduation requirement, however it is required if pursuing the full-IB Diploma Program
 - Two years of the same World Language ARE required for entrance into 4-year Universities
