



Camp Invention (Elementary K-4th)

Camp Exploration (5th-7th grade)—3 period day

- English Language Arts or Language Acquisition for Multilingual scholars
- Math class

Camp Acceleration (8th-12th grade)—3 period day

- Minimum of one transitional boot camp for ELA and/or MATH course for entering high school students, current 8th-12th graders.
- 1-2 elective opportunities: music, pottery, drama, cooking, band, orchestra, etc.

Traditional BAND and/or JAZZ Band camp or CHOIR—3 hours/day--weekly sessions






