**For students applying to SCIS from another Shanghai international school, school policy may prevent you from requesting a Letter of Reccomendation. In this case, a certificate of enrollment and complete academic school reports may be sufficient.

• Families that are applying to SCIS from overseas may submit residence and work permits within 60 days of the student joining SCIS, if those documents are still being processed at the time of application.

- If a family has parents with different nationalities they can choose which application route to follow. Each family must complete all requirements of one column.
- SCIS requires all students who hold foreign passports to have a valid visa to stay in China (Not required for PRC passport holders).
- Please note that SCIS follows the eligibility criteria set by SHMEC, which may be subject to change without notice.

APPLICATION FEE PAYMENT OPTIONS

Application Fee (RMB 2,500, VAT included)

The application fee is non-refundable and payable when the student's application is completed and submitted to the school for consideration. This fee is not applicable to other school fees but is valid for up to one academic year beyond the submitted application date. No application will be reviewed until this fee is paid in full.

Methods of Payment:

- Fees may be paid by bank transfer (see further instructions below).
- Fees may be paid by check, in RMB or US dollars (according to the daily rate of exchange), at any of our campuses.
- Fees may be paid in RMB cash at any of our campuses. We are not able to accept US dollar cash payments.
- Fees may be paid by credit/debit card (we accept all major credit cards, however transaction fees will be the responsibility of the payer).
