- Department updates
 - Health Office The fire department was kind enough to offer CPR training at no cost for staff. The second day was canceled due to the total number of people signed up for the course. We just moved everyone to one day. Approximately 5 people attended the training. Lori Desjardin, Carrie Patel, Tricia McGean and I were also certified for BLS through the fire department. Stop the Bleed training will be held on January 24. Using SNAP to log how many people are seen in the health office. It has been working well, integrates with PowerSchool.

 - Health Education
 - January: 7th grade depression/Signs of Suicide (SOS) screening Offered every year, has been a part of the curriculum for many years. Monday, January 23 the screening will take place by Meghan and Kim Reid. Homeroom teachers will play 2 videos 6 minutes each about a child in crisis. The acronym ACT (acknowledge, care, tell) is used. The students are given a questionnaire that day. Someone should touch base with Kaitlyn Olmstead to make sure she is comfortable and familiar with the process.
 - Panorama questionnaire will go out soon. They also do a version at the high school level as well as middle school. Meghan and Kim talked about doing a refresher but they may hold off since Panorama provides a lot of information.
