All courses offered in grades Developmental Kindergarten through 12th grade have curriculum approved by the district's Advisory Curriculum Committee (ACC).

Virtual learning options are also offered through ACC-approved curriculum courses aligned to state standards and created and taught by Davison staff, the Genesee Intermediate School District's Gen-NET portal and the Virtual Learning Academy Consortium (VLAC) program operated by Oakland Schools. All courses offered through Gen-NET have been reviewed to ensure that they are aligned to Michigan state standards.
