JOB SUMMARY: Ensure prompt and efficient delivery of supplies,

equipment, mail, and other materials.

#### PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Travel to and from locations to pick—up or deliver materials such as mail, supplies, equipment and other materials in a manner that is prompt, efficient and safe.

- 3. Perform and coordinate the loading and unloading of various vehicles.

- Must have valid driver's license
- Submission of pre-employment medical examination (Section 148 of the Pennsylvania School Code)
- Submission of a report of criminal history record from the Pennsylvania State Police (Section 111 of the Pennsylvania School Code)
- Submission of a clearance report from the Pennsylvania Department of Public Welfare in accordance with Act 151 of 1994
- ullet Submission of Federal Criminal History Report in accordance with Act 114 of 2006
- Submission of Arrest/Conviction Report and Certification Form per Act 24 of 2011
- Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Board of Directors may find appropriate and acceptable
