Who is Eligible?

-  Must be at least two pages, and no more than three pages.
-  Essay must be typed or neatly handwritten.
-  If typed, it must be double spaced.
-  Must be on 8.5” x 11” paper
-  The official entry form must be attached.
-  Immediate family members of Community Trust Bank employees are not eligible.

Deadline

All entries must be given to the participant’s high school guidance counselor by *March 29, 2024*.

Criteria for Judging

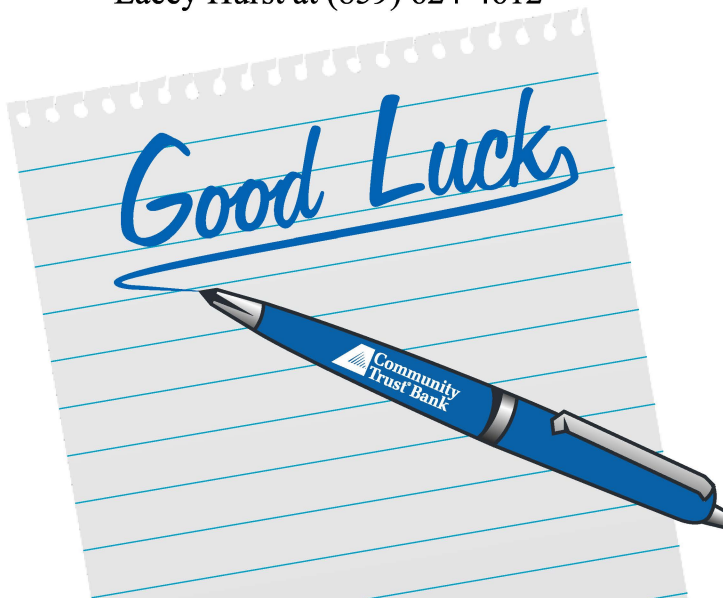
Essays will be judged on 75% content, and 25% grammar, spelling and punctuation.
