To the Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2028:

Greetings from Central High School! I am sure it does not seem possible, but soon your child will complete middle school and begin high school. We are in the initial stages of pre-registration for next year, and in order to make this transition as smooth as possible, we would like to inform you of the **four-step** process to pre-register your student for high school.

First Step... Central High School counselors will present to our two feeder middle schools. Counselors will talk with students about their Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP), high school credits, graduation requirements, athletic eligibility requirements, and other ways to be successful in high school. These dates are as follows:

February 20th: Truman Middle School Counselor Visit
February 21st: Bode Middle School Counselor Visit

During this time, CHS counselors will provide students with pre-registration information and a course request form for you to review. The course request form provides a list of classes that students can request to take their freshmen year. Please read course descriptions and select course requests and alternates carefully since the requests will be used for students' official schedules. Course descriptions are available in the course catalog on the CHS Counseling website (<https://central.sjsd.k12.mo.us/student-support/counseling>). Students will need the course request form when completing the preregistration process.

Second Step... Future Indian Night will be held Wednesday, February 21st 6:30-8:00 PM. Central High School. This is an open house, and we encourage you to come meet your future teachers, counselors, coaches, and principals and see all the activities and athletics that CHS has to offer!

Third Step... Students at both Truman and Bode Middle School will make their course requests in PowerSchool. The courses selected during pre-registration are requests only, and official schedules will not be available until August. CHS counselors will be at the middle school buildings and available to answer any questions about preregistration. These dates are as follows:

February 23rd : Truman Course Request Day
February 23rd : Bode Course Request Day

Fourth Step... In August, registration will take place for all students. At this time, students will be able to access their official schedules in PowerSchool. If first choices were not granted, then every effort will be made to give the student his/her alternate choices.
