All Indiana students are required to complete Box 2 requirements for Graduation Pathways. Students can do so by being active in clubs, sports, and other extracurricular activities. Students must complete 80 hours of service (8 points) during their time in high school. It is 80 hours over the 4 years, not 80 hours per year. Students participating in activities not listed above are encouraged to talk with their school counselors to see if those activities can count toward the Box 2 requirement.
