COSMETOLOGY PROGRAM

The School of Cosmetology at Simi Institute offers four certificate programs including Barber, Cosmetologist, Esthetician, and Manicurist. These intensive, hands-on programs prepare students for successful careers in the beauty industry. Upon completing all required levels and hours, a culminating state board class will prepare students for the passage of the written and practical California State Board exams. All classes are conducted in-person only, except for Related Science (Health & Safety).

NEW COHORTS BEGIN FIVE TIMES PER YEAR

Students must be 18 years, and speak, read, and write English at 9th grade level. All students must successfully complete the prerequisite Related Science (Health & Safety) course before beginning core classes.

RELATED SCIENCE (HEALTH & SAFETY)

Related Science (Health & Safety) is a **PREREQUISITE** course for all barber, cosmetologist, esthetician, and manicurist students. This week-long, self-paced online course covers a variety of basic science concepts related to a career in the beauty industry. Students gain the foundational knowledge to apply to future classes in hair care, skin care, and nail care. Course fee included with all Level 1 core class tuition.

BARBER - 1,000 HOURS

Learn the fundamentals of men's hair dressing, skin care, and shaving. Students complete a series of courses in hairstyling, hair cutting, hair coloring, permanent waving, chemical straightening, men's facials, men's manicures, shaving, and facial hair design. Students will also learn basic business and salon management skills as well as the basics of men's hair replacement.

Level 1: \$1,905

COSMETOLOGIST - 1,000 HOURS

Learn the fundamentals of hair care, skin care, and nail care. Students complete a series of courses in hair styling, hair cutting, hair coloring, permanent waving, makeup, facials, manicuring, and pedicuring. Students also learn basic business and salon management skills. Advanced students perform a variety of services in our onsite salon with instructor supervision.

Level 1: \$1,905

ESTHETICIAN - 600 HOURS

Learn the fundamentals of skin care. Students take a series of courses to learn procedures for skin analysis, performing a variety of facials, chemical exfoliation, waxing, the use of galvanic and high frequency machines, paraffin wax, and basic makeup applications. Advanced students perform a variety of services in our onsite salon under the supervision of instructors.

Level 1: \$1,605

MANICURIST - 400 HOURS

Learn the fundamentals of nail technology. Students take a series of courses to learn procedures for manicuring, pedicuring, nail tips, nail enhancements, gels, massage, paraffin wax, and advanced nail art. Advanced students perform a variety of services in our onsite salon under the supervision of instructors.

Level 1: \$1,105

HAIRSTYLIST - COMING SOON!

The new hairstylist program is expected to cover hair styling services including arranging, blow drying, cleansing, curling, dressing, hair analysis, shampooing, waving, nonchemical straightening, and hair cutting including the use of shears, razors, electrical clippers and trimmers, and thinning shears for wet and dry cutting.
