Gifted and Talented Education Task Force Update

Goal: Revisit Qualification Process

- Examine: 115 students identified (4.7%) with OLSAT-8
 - Disproportionate representation: Hispanic/Latino (under); Asian (over); White (over)
 - 62% English Only (EO)
 - 15% Initial Fluent English Proficient (IFEP)
 - 23% Reclassified Fluent English Proficient (RFEP)
 - 0% English Learner (EL)
- Explore: Additional Processes to serve Lawndale students

GATE Qualification Process ~ NEW

Two Methods:

- 1. Intellectual Ability for Grade 3
 - Score of 95% or above on Naglieri (NNAT#3)
 - All 3rd grade students will be universally screened in Spring
- 2. High Achievement for Grades 4-7
 - A score of 3 points from the Rubric below:
 - Naglieri: Scoring within 84th-94th percentile on NNAT3 (1 point)
 - SBAC: Score of 4 in both ELA & Math for two consecutive years (2 points)
 - SBAC: Score of 4 in one content for two consecutive years (1 point)
 - Teacher recommendation (1 point)
 - Status: English Learner, Foster Youth, Low Income (1 point)
