





## HOMECOMING 2013 - SAVE THE DATE




**Jim Gooch '85**




**Steve Jaksa '74** the Head Baseball Coach at Central Michigan University the only GB Grad to be Division 1 head coach in any sport.

## STEVE JAKSA to Enter Alumni Hall of Fame As the only NCAA Division I Coach from Grand Blanc High School



This October 5<sup>th</sup> marks the next induction ceremony for distinguished alumni from Grand Blanc High School. One such alumnus is Steve Jaska, Class of 1974, who currently coaches varsity baseball at Central Michigan University.

Steve is believed to be the first and only Grand Blanc grad to head a NCAA Division I team.

Steve's career took a circuitous route to Mt. Pleasant and the Chippewas. Following graduation from CMU in 1979, he coached football, basketball and baseball in the early 80's at GBHS while teaching at Holy Family. He then went to Lake Fenton from 1982-84 where he was the head basketball coach and where he met his future wife, Patty. From Lake Fenton, Steve went to Flint Southwestern where he coached the Colts to a Valley Championship in baseball.

Next for Steve were stops at Saginaw Nouvel (baseball coach and athletic director) and Northwood College before he landed the assistant baseball coach at CMU in June of 1998. Four years later, Steve became the head coach of the Chippewa baseball team where he has been ever since, enjoying great success.

Steve was elated to hear of his coming induction. In a recent telephone conversation, he said "I am truly honored and humbled to receive this honor. Grand Blanc holds special for me and my siblings who also graduated from GBHS. I will forever be indebted to the teachers and coaches who taught and mentored me in my four years there."
