From March 15th the following rewards and consequences will be in place:

Incentives:

4 weeks with no infractions	field trip, email home, publicized to the community
3 weeks with no infractions	pizza, email home, publicized to the community
2 weeks with no infractions	coffee, email home, publicized to the community
1 week with no infractions	sweet treat, email home, publicized to the community

Consequences

2+ infractions	Detention (1 hour at lunchtime – no phones)
3+ infractions	Detention (3 days, 1 hour at lunchtime – no phones) Email home
5+ infractions	Detention (all week, 1 hour lunchtime – no phones) Email home, contract, N for group interaction
10+ infractions	In-school suspension, 2 days. Email home, contract, N for group interaction and responsibility

Formal Language Contract:

Stage One: Contract with student and director. Students agree to fewer violations, or they will move to stage two.

Stage Two: Contract with student, director, parents. Continued violations, student will be asked to withdraw for the following school year or repeat literacy (reading and writing).
