REDO / RETEST GUIDELINES

In accordance with state and local guidelines, students at Dean Middle School are permitted to retest/redo according to the following:

Check for Understanding Grades (Daily Assignments)

- A student may redo **at least one** failing daily grade per grading period.
- The highest grade a student can earn on a redone assignment will be a 70.
- All redos must be offered and completed by the end of the grading period.
- A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.
- Teachers should work with students to ensure mastery of appropriate TEKS related to the assignment.

Relevant Application Assessments

- A student receiving a grade lower than a 70 may retest.
- A student may redo **at least one** failing relevant application per grading period.
- The student should participate in an intervening action (tutorials, study group, test corrections, etc.) for reteaching before the retest.
- All retests must be offered and completed by the end of the grading period.
- The student may receive a grade no higher than a 70 on the retest/redo.
- A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.
- Teachers may work with students through re-teaching opportunities in order to allow students to demonstrate mastery of the TEKS for the redo grade.

Summative Assessments (Tests)

- A student receiving a grade lower than a 70 may retest.
- A student may retest **one** grade per grading period.
- The student should participate in an intervening action (tutorials, study group, test corrections, etc.) for reteaching before the retest.
- All retests must be offered and completed by the end of the grading period.
- The student may receive a grade no higher than a 70 on the retest.
- A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.
- The teacher may schedule an assigned day for retesting.

**DPMs and Benchmarks are not included in the redo/retest opportunities.*
