Academic Preparation and Developing the whole student for 8th and 9th Grade Students

The transition from Middle School to High School is scary for most students. For some students, the new level of academic rigor at their new school is a source of stress and concern. To help ease this transition, Archbishop Hannan High School, offers the Propel to Success Summer Program from June 3 - June 21, 2024.

The Propel to Success Summer Program is a three-week academic support and enrichment program for students preparing to enter the 8th and 9th grades who the school has felt have demonstrated a need, or those who desire extra academic preparation. Staffed by Archbishop Hannan faculty, the Propel Program is designed to prepare incoming students to perform academically at the level expected of all Archbishop Hannan students.

Class sizes are limited.

Schedule and Dates

Classes are held Monday through Friday mornings, June 3 – June 21, 2024.

Course Information

- **Mathematics:** This course is designed for the student who has mastered the basic skills of mathematics but would like to strengthen their critical math skills for success in Pre-Algebra and Algebra I. Topics will include understanding and working with fractions, real numbers, adding and subtracting negative numbers, using the distributive property to simplify expressions, solving linear equations, and modeling real life problems with equations.
- **Grammar/Language:** This course will further acquaint a student with the proper ways to employ spoken and written English. Practice in punctuation, sentence structure, proof-reading, vocabulary development, and paragraph construction will help prepare a student for his/her English courses.
- **Hawk Life:** This new course is multidimensional in developing the whole student and will teach students about life as a Hannan Hawk. Participating students will receive their laptops and technology training on using CANVAS, PowerSchool, and emails. Participants will also be introduced into high school student life and faith formation.

The Propel to Success Summer Program courses are not for school credit and are not intended as credit recovery courses. Students should expect homework during these courses.

Attendance

Dress Code

A summer school student's general appearance is to be neat, clean, and well groomed at all times. The specifics of the code are defined as follows: **BOYS:** A dress shirt or knit shirt with a collar, dress pants or blue jeans (must be neat and in good repair without any holes/tears), casual shoes (no gym shoes, flip flop sandals). Shorts and pants of extreme color/fit/pattern will not be allowed. **GIRLS:** A knit shirt or a blouse with a collar and sleeves is to be worn with dress pants or blue jeans (must be neat and in good repair without any holes/tears) or a dress skirt. Summer dresses may be worn provided that the neckline is appropriate for school. Skirt and dress lengths must reach to a minimum 2" above the knee. Casual shoes or dress sandals must be worn (no gym shoes, flip flop sandals). Shorts, capris, leggings, lycra, biker, stretch, spandex or any other tight pants are absolutely forbidden.

We realize appropriate school dress and appearance do not necessarily coincide with current fashions. The final determination of appropriate dress and appearance is left to the discretion of school administrators. Students out of dress code may be sent home to change; time missed from the program will be unexcused.

Tuition and Fees

The Propel to Success Summer Program fee is \$900.00 for Math, English, and Hawk Life or \$500.00 for Math or English or Hawk Life plus the cost of any course materials. Tuition must be paid in full by accessing the Payment Portal on the Hannan website and click on Propel Registration by May 17, 2024. All payments are non-refundable.
