# **POST PANDEMIC RECOVERY**



While school closures and remote learning resulted in unprecedented declines in EOG/EOC test scores for 21-22, results for 22-23 show strong gains.



North Carolina students are continuing to recover ground lost, with gains across virtually all grades, subjects, and student subgroups.



NC also showed progress on accountability measures. More than seven of every 10 met or exceeded, with not met just 1% higher than 18-19.




Superintendent Truitt, has stated that last year's accountability results show that schools remain on track to recover from COVID-19 setbacks.






## Performance Composite: All Subjects and Grade Levels






**Every Student Succeeds Act Accountability Model** 

### **ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURES**



- Performance: The percentage of students who score at Achievement Levels 3-5 or meet Career and College Readiness Indicators
  - Achievement Levels 3-5 are considered Proficient
    - Achievement Level 3 is considered Grade-level Proficient
    - Achievement Levels 4 and 5 are considered Career and College Ready
- Growth: An indication of the rate at which students in the school learned over the past year
  - The standard is roughly equivalent to a year's worth of growth for a year of instruction
  - Growth is reported for each school as:
    - Exceeded Growth Expectations;
    - Met Growth Expectations; or
    - Did Not Meet Growth Expectations



## NC Accountability Components: Elementary & Middle

#### **Academic Achievement**

- EOG assessments in Reading and Mathematics in grades 3-8.
- EOG Science assessments in grades 5 & 8.
- EOC assessments in middle school.
- EL Progress: ACCESS for English Learners (EL) assessment

#### **School Accountability Growth**

- English Language Arts in grades 3-8
- Math in grades 4-8
- Science in grades 5 & 8





## NC Accountability Components: High Schools



- **EOC Assessments:** NC Math 1, English II, Biology, and NC Math 3
- Graduation Rate: The percentage of students who graduate in four years or less.
- Math Course Rigor: The percentage of students enrolled in Grade 12 passing NC Math 3
- The ACT: The percentage of students meeting the UNC system admissions requirement of a composite score of 19.
- ACT Workkeys: The percentage of Career and Technical Education (CTE) concentrators in Grade 12 that are awarded at least a Silver Level Career Readiness Certificate based on the ACT Workkeys assessment.
- EL Progress: The percent of EL students making progress on the ACCESS assessment.


