ACHEVING POSTSECONDARY READINESS

To demonstrate postsecondary readiness, a high school senior must be in good standing to earn a high school diploma AND satisfy ONE (or more) of Kentucky's approved postsecondary readiness criteria below:

1. Meet an ACT or KYOTE State Benchmark

✓ Meet Kentucky mandated benchmarks in English or Reading or Math/Algebra on either an ACT or KYOTE test.

2. Pass a CTE EOP Assessment

- ✓ Pass a Career & Technical Education (CTE) End-of-Program (EOP) Assessment with a 70% or higher score.
- ✓ Students who have completed two (2) courses in an approved pathway will take a CTE EOP test in the spring semester.

2. Earn an Industry Certification

- ✓ Earn an industry certification in an approved career pathway.
- ✓ Check with your CTE teacher to see if you are eligible to test.

4. Earn Dual Credit or AP Credit

- ✓ Complete and earn a "C" or better in a KDE approved dual credit course.
- ✓ Take an earn a "3" or higher on a KDE approved Advanced Placement (AP) course assessment.
