Honors Requirements:

Honors English	Prerequisite: 90+ in Honors English 8 th grade (for each qtr. & sem.) & a 93+ writing average, if applicable. For College Prep a 95+ in English & 95+ in 8 th grade Essentials of Writing.
Honors World History I	Prerequisite: An average of 88+ in Honors English or 95+ in College Prep English, and a 95+ in 8 th grade US History
Honors Algebra	Prerequisite: 85+ average in 8 th Grade Honors Algebra I or 95+ average in 8 th grade Essentials of Algebra
Honors Geometry	Prerequisite: Enrolled in Accelerated Algebra I or 95+ average in 8 th grade Honors Algebra I with standardized test results and administrative recommendation, if applicable.
Honors Algebra II	Prerequisite: 85+ average in Honors Geometry
Honors Biology	Prerequisite: 90+ average in 8 th grade Honors Physical Science & Honors Math or 95+ in Science & Math Courses.
Honors Wind Ensemble & Honors Commercial Music Ens.	Audition & director's approval.
World Language	To begin World Lang. studies in grade 9, students must have an 80+ avg. in English 8 or recommendation of their English teacher. Students who took Latin I, French I, or Spanish I in grade 8 must take levels II and III in high school, if they continue with the same language.
S.T.E.M.	85+ average in Math and Science. Excel in Lab opportunities and must be able to <u>take two consecutive STEM</u> classes. <u>Application Required.</u> STEM classes may count toward the third lab-based science. It is recommended that students continue to take additional science course beyond biology and chemistry in conjunction with STEM curriculum.

Academic Diploma with Honors Endorsement Requirements: 24 credits, plus a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.8 in grades 9-12, that include six (6) credits in Honors and/or Advanced Placement courses from the BCS core classes of: English, Science, Math, Social Studies, World Languages or Bible.

Academic Diploma with Fine Arts Endorsement: 24 credits in grades 9-12 that include five (5) credits in fine/performing arts and a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Academic Diploma with Fine Arts and Honors Endorsement Requirements: 24 credits in grades 9-12 that include six (6) credits in Honors and/or Advanced Placement courses, five (5) credits in fine/performing arts and a seven-semester weighted GPA of 3.8 or higher. Students must declare intent to pursue this option when entering the 9th grade.
