Call to order: 12:04 pm

Members Present: Tina Dendy, Kayla Kutzler, Selorm Boateng, Dr. Oban, Lila Brendel, and Kasoingo Mutebo. Joined by Google Meet: Deirdre Bostyan, Lance Hendrickson, Janelle Combs, Denise Spitzer, Rebecca Lacher, Karen Dunlap, and Mandy Dendy.

Review and Approval of September 2021 Minutes: Motion by Selorm Boateng, second by Kayla Kutzler, all in favor.

Treasurer's Report: previous balance was \$7,787.45, after paying \$58.12 for envelopes and labels, and \$630.65 for printing for the raffle the new and current balance is \$7,098.68. Tina Dendy moved to approve, seconded by Karen Dunlap and the motion passed.

Administration Report: Dr. Oban let us know that the previously mentioned school goals and framework are now listed on the school's website under the About Us section. He went over TikTok trends and issues we have faced as a result. We discussed how this has affected staff and how it would not be tolerated. Traffic for pick-ups and drop-offs is becoming more streamlined however there are still a few points of confusion as to which lanes are for stopping. He discussed the future road work on Ash Coulee Drive and the tentative plans we could have to deal with traffic during the time the road is being worked on.

Activity Report:

- Tina Dendy went over raffle tickets being distributed and discussed needing volunteers to count tickets and for record keeping for the raffle. A sign up will be sent out to parents.
- Selorm Boateng brought up the issue of signatories on the PAC bank account. The treasurer and president are supposed to be listed according to the by-laws. Karen Dunlap moved to add Selorm Boateng and remove Darla Miller as she is no longer on the council, seconded by Rebecca Lacher and motion carried.

- We voted on whether to do teacher/staff appreciation, it was decided that we would do it on the 3rd or 4th Wednesday of each month starting in November. Karen Dunlap volunteered to chair this.
- Parent-teacher conferences will be October 28th and November 2nd and PAC will be providing meals for these nights. There is approximately a \$50/night budget set aside for this. A sign up will be emailed to parents to ask for help with this effort.
- Selorm Boateng discussed PAC participation and possibly meeting with other PACs in the district to find a way to boost participation.

Discussion: A parent had a question about the place religion and sexuality have in the curriculum of the school. Dr. Oban explained that due to the separation of church and state these things are not taught in public schools.
