#### **NPHS Athletic Boosters Scholarship**

- Deadline to apply: April 16
- Criteria: Participated in at least one athletic team all four years at NPHS (\*Seniors missed freshmen year due to Covid)
- Parent membership and significant volunteer service to the Athletic Boosters Club
- Awards: (2) \$1500 one male and one female athlete with 3.00 GPA
  - (2) \$1000 one male and one female athlete with 2.50 GPA

#### **NPHS PTSO Scholarship**

Deadline to apply: April 16

Criteria: Community service, school involvement, min GPA 2.50

Award: (2) \$500 each

#### Rachel A. Thomas Scholarship

- Deadline to apply: April 15
- Eligible: Seniors in the NPHS JROTC, Criminal Justice Program, Cheer Team, or Girls Basketball Team
- Criteria: Min GPA 2.50, 2 or 4-year college-bound, official transcript, two letters of recommendation, essay topic provided
- Award: four awards (one from each group) \$500 each
