Buildings and Grounds Committee Minutes

FEASIBILITY STUDY / LONG RANGE PLANNING

Mr. Stoltzfus provided a brief status update on the Early Childhood Center, noting the electrical switchgear shipped on Friday and is expected to arrive on site this week. The schedule indicates approximately three months of activities before the building is completed. On Monday, the architect and contractor walked the High School to document the punch list.

Mr. Davis provided a brief update on the Critical Capital Projects.

Based on feedback from the January 16, 2024, Buildings and Grounds Committee and February 12, 2024, Finance Committee meetings, further information was sought regarding the Comprehensive Renovations for Martin Meylin Middle School. Dr. Peart provided a background regarding the steps taken as part of the Feasibility Study from 2018 to current and referenced the District website with each of the public presentations. Mr. Levato then provided a presentation documenting the prior approvals and needs for comprehensive renovations of Martin Meylin Middle School. Following Board member questions and discussion, all were asked by Mr. Welk if they supported continuing moving forward with the project. No further questions were asked and there was no opposition voiced with moving forward with the project.

Due to time constraints, Mr. Welk recommended tabling the remaining agenda items and all agreed.
