

Device Recommendations for the 2024-25 School Year

Trinity Preparatory School requires all students to have a device meeting the following minimum requirements. *Families are advised to wait to purchase new devices until after June 1 to maximize access to the latest inventory and the commencement of the warranty effective date.*



Chromebooks are no longer recommended as devices for students. Due to changing program and testing requirements, we can no longer encourage using personal Chromebooks at any grade level. Current students will be grandfathered in until they reach grade 9, at which they will be expected to transition to full laptop devices.

Warranty & Accessories:

- A 3-year warranty with Accidental Damage Protection (Example: AppleCare+) is *strongly* recommended. You may choose to purchase support services for your laptop through the manufacturer or retailer of the laptop. Often, these vendors have on-site support plans that are more convenient than standard "over-the-phone" support plans.
- A suitable neoprene sleeve or hard case which will fit into a backpack is recommended.
- All Apple and Windows devices must have malware and antivirus software installed. Families are encouraged to use products they are familiar with for home or business use. Recommendations will be available during the onboarding process for the new school year over the summer.
