Goal #1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Engage in a mindset shift that redefines comprehension grounded in the Science of Reading.</li></ul>
Goal #2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Incorporate knowledge about the multiple processes of reading comprehension into instruction.</li></ul>
Goal #3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Reflect and determine how to guide the development of students' mental models before reading, during reading, and after reading.</li></ul>
