What is ILEARN?

Subject	Grade(s)
ILEARN English/Language Arts	Grades 3–8
ILEARN Mathematics	Grades 3–8
ILEARN Science	Grades 4 and 6
ILEARN Social Studies	Grade 5
ILEARN Biology End-of-Course Assessment (ECA)	High School*
ILEARN U.S. Government End-of-Course Assessment (ECA)(optional)	High School*

*Taken at the end of the course, regardless of grade level.

- Indiana’s Online Assessment
- Designed to measure a student’s proficiency with Indiana Academic Standards
- Fulfills both state and federal legislative requirements as the accountability assessment for Indiana students

When will we test?

- 2023-2024 Assessment Window
 - April 15 – May 10, 2024
 - North plans to start Tuesday, April 16
 - South plans to start Tuesday, April 23
- Each school will set their own testing schedule within the window
- Practice Test will be given the week or two before the test

ELA	75-100 minutes	80-130 minutes
Math	85-125 minutes	35-55 minutes

DOK Levels

A measure of the demand or thought processes required to complete a given task.

Defined by the *task*, not by student performance.

Prohibited During Testing

- No Smart Phones or Smartwatches allowed in the testing room
- No music/ background noise



Important Reminders

- ILEARN tests are UNTIMED!
 - CAT - Students can pause the and return to a test later in the day or the next day
 - PT – must be completed within the same day
- **ATTENDANCE is extremely important!!**
- Students should get plenty of sleep, put electronics away at night, and eat a good breakfast!

When will scores be released?

- Scores will be released to the school within 12 days of test completion
- Scores report will be sent to parents by the end of the school year.
- Rescore window May 13-31
 - Parent has to reach out to the school to request the rescore

ILEARN Policy Performance Level Descriptors

Below Proficiency

Indiana students **below proficiency have not met** current grade level standards. Students may require **significant support to develop the knowledge, application, and analytical skills needed** to be on track for college and career readiness.

Approaching Proficiency

Indiana students **approaching proficiency have nearly met** current grade level standards by demonstrating some **basic** knowledge, application, and **limited** analytical skills. Students may **require support** to be on track for college and career readiness.

At Proficiency

Indiana students **at proficiency have met** current grade level standards by demonstrating **essential** knowledge, application, and analytical skills to be on track for college and career readiness.

Above Proficiency

Indiana students **above proficiency have mastered** current grade level standards by demonstrating **more complex** knowledge, application, and analytical skills to be on track for college and career readiness.
