(10th graders may now apply with their Fall semester grades.)

## Life Membership (Gold Sealbearer)

*Life Membership is achieved by:*

1. Four or more qualifying semesters in the last three years of high school (10th-12th grade semesters).
2. One of the 4 qualifying semesters must be from grades earned during the SENIOR year. Students who earn Gold Seal Bearer status will be recognized by wearing a gold tassel at graduation and earning the CSF Gold Seal on their diploma and transcript.

**No late applications accepted.**

Once submitted and approved, you will receive an email confirmation which you will show to Ms. Santoro/ ASB Student Store and pay the CSF fee of \$5.00.

A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

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1. You must earn 10 points from last semester's grades. (Please double check your calculations.)
  - a. The first 4 points must be from LIST I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or June).
  - b. The first 7 points (including the four points described in part a ) must be from LIST I or LISTS I and II.
  - c. The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II, and III).

**No** CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.

2. CSF points are granted as follows: **A = 3**      **B = 1**      **C = 0**

One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course.

A grade of D or F in any course, even if not counted for CSF, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

- Semester membership is based on work done in the previous semester.
- You must reapply each semester.
- A list of courses you may use are attached. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.
- List the courses you are using to qualify in the proper column. (Consult the lists on the next page).
- Only up to five (5) classes may be used to qualify.

**Step 1:** Go to <https://aeries.nmusd.us/aeries.net/parent>

**Step 2:** Log in with your username and password

Your username email is your student ID#@nmusd.us (example: 123456@nmusd.us)

Click on sign in with Google, then click Next

Your password is your network login ID used to get on the computers at school. If you do not know your network login ID, please see Mary Russell in the Learning Resource Center (LRC).

**Step 3:** Click on the Grades tab, then click on Transcripts
