## Course Introduction



The ACT® is a college admissions exam that consists of four subject area tests: English, mathematics, reading, and science (plus an optional writing test). This tutorial will help you prepare for the science portion of the exam. We'll review the topics assessed on the ACT® and give you opportunities to practice your skills.

The ACT® science test focuses on assessing the student's ability to think logically, draw conclusions, and analyze data, all of which should be supported by the student's knowledge of natural sciences up to date.

In this tutorial, we will walk you through the structure of the test and review the specific topics covered on this portion of the exam.
