Opt in Essay for SAT Testing Update for 11th Graders:

- Update 02/16/2024: Students can not longer opt in gfor the optional essay for the SAT.

- For PSAT and SAT testing: students **may not use a personal windows and mac laptops and tablets**, only BVSD 1:Web chromebook, or a school loaner chromebook
- For CMAS SCI 11: students can only use a BVSD 1:Web chromebook or school loaner chromebook.
- If your student has a BVSD 1:Web chromebook that needs repair, they should stop by the library as soon as possible to ensure it is repaired by testing.
