

Grade Level Grading Expectations

6th Grade:

All assignments will have an original due date. Once the assignment is late, an "M" will be entered into IC and the LDA (last date of acceptance) will be entered into the comment section of IC.

Late assignments will be accepted up to 4 school days late (Monday to Monday, Tuesday to Tuesday, etc.) 5% will be removed for each day late, so the highest grade they can receive if turned in on the last day of acceptance is 80%.

7th Grade:

All assignments will have an original due date. Once the assignment is late, an "M" will be entered into IC and the LDA (last date of acceptance) will be entered into the comment section of IC.

Late assignments will be accepted up to 4 school days late (Monday to Monday, Tuesday to Tuesday, etc.) Once an assignment is late, the highest grade they can receive is a 75%.

Zeros "0" will be given for any assignment that is not turned in by the LDA. The LDA will remain in the comment section of IC as a reference for the student/parent. **(Exceptions of this would only be applied to Summative Assessments in ELA.)**

8th Grade:

All assignments will have an original due date. Once the assignment is late, an "M" will be entered into IC and the LDA (last date of acceptance) will be entered into the comment section of IC.

Any late assignment needs to be turned in by Thursday of the following week. For example, an assignment due Tuesday 8/16, we will only accept it (late) by Thursday the 8/25.

When an assignment is late, there is an automatic 25% deduction.

For ELA: The original assignment must be turned in by the late date in order to make revisions for grade increase. Once turned in, you can make unlimited revisions on certain assignments for up to 100% (if on time) or 75% (if late).
