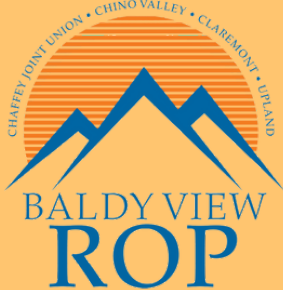

# GOLDEN BELL AWARD WINNER BVROP ENGINEERING INSTRUCTOR MICHAEL COLLINS



Mr. Collins is an exceptional instructor and holds the Golden Bell Award as proof. The CSBA Golden Bell Awards® promote excellence in education by recognizing outstanding programs throughout California. The Golden Bell Awards honors successful models, techniques and supporting data focused on efforts to prepare students for both career and college.

Mr. Collins shared that BVROP engineering classes maintain cross-discipline collaboration with History, Science, and English classes that provide students a multi-year STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) and CTE (Career Technical Education) pathway focusing on engineering and architecture. BVROP engineering classes also earn college credits, are UC a-g approved, and count as a science elective.

Students are involved in multiple local, regional, and national competitions; such as the ACE (Architecture, Construction, Engineering) Mentorship program. The ACE Mentorship program is an after school program designed to attract high school students to pursue careers in the architecture, construction and engineering industry. This affiliation also increases awareness and participation of female students in STEM.

BVROP engineering courses invoke hands-on learning with physical models, sketches, data documentation, and 3-D modeling software. This approach encourages students to adopt a problem-solving mindset, working individually and in teams to design solutions to both residential and commercial projects. Students also use architectural design software to prepare them for post-secondary programs and careers.

Students have earned scholarships and internships at world renown entities such as Boeing, JGMA Architects in Chicago, and Northrop Grumman. Students have also been accepted and earned scholarships to some of the most prestigious colleges in the country such as Caltech and UC Berkeley. Baldy View ROP is offered at Ayala High School in the Chino Valley Unified School District. Please see engineering courses below:

11/ 29/ 22

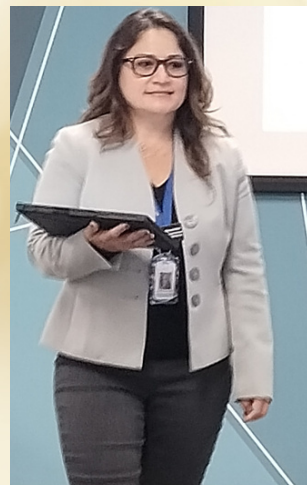
