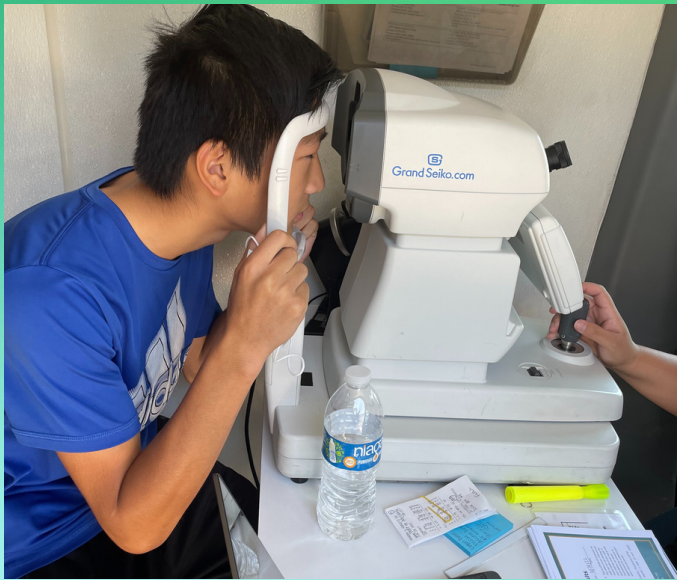


# Summer Eyewear School-to-Home Events 06/29/22 and 07/18/22
