Here are the finalists for Upstate high school girls basketball top performers for the week of Feb.19-25 in the state playoffs. Multiple votes are allowed. Polls will close at 5 p.m. Wednesday.

Last week's winner was Woodruff's Sadie Burnette, who edged out Wren's Raina McGowens with 51.4 percent to 49.1 percent of more than 48,000 votes.

Here are this week's finalists listed in alphabetical order:

Monasia Clinkscales, Westside: Clinkscales led Westside with 16 points in a 44-30 win against North Augusta in the Class AAAA Upper State semifinals.

Madison Garrido, Riverside: Garrido had 13 points, four assists and three steals in a 63-61 win against top-ranked South Pointe in the Class AAAA Upper State semifinals.

Deyana Hayes, Wren: Hayes had 17 points and 15 rebounds in a 58-25 win against West-Oak in Class AAA.

Lola Kelly, St. Joseph's: Kelly scored 17 points to lead St. Joseph's past Christ Church, 52-49, in the Class A Upper State semifinals.

Raina McGowens, Wren: McGowens had 28 points, eight rebounds and five assists against West-Oak.

Niyah Wilson, Daniel: Wilson scored 19 points as Daniel beat Blue Ridge, 63-40, in the Class AAA Upper State semifinals.
