Q&A about Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports

What is PBIS?

Program geared towards teaching positive social behaviors by implementing universal positive behavior support for the classroom, lunchroom, hallways, media center, office, field trips, restrooms, bus, etc...

What PBIS program is used at Johnson?

We are currently implementing the PBIS Rewards program, which is an online system that allows students to earn individual digital points which they use to purchase items from the Wildcat school store. Students will be able to login to the PBIS rewards student dashboard to purchase items from the school store. There will also be four school wide incentives in which students may participate if they did NOT have an office discipline referral during the 9 weeks preceding the event.



How can my child earn points?

Students earn points by following the P.A.W.S school wide expectations. The expectations are... **Prepare, Act responsibly, Work and play safe, Show respect.**

Are there other requirements to participate in school wide incentives?

Yes. Students must not have any office discipline referrals during the 9 weeks preceding the school wide event. If a student does receive an office discipline referral, they will **NOT** be allowed to participate in the school wide incentive.

How can I receive more information?

What can I do to help my child?

Learn the expectations – Ask your child if he/she has received any **points** – Talk to your child's teacher about your child's behavior – Congratulate your child when he/she earns points to reinforce positive behavior. Students receive regular updates of how many points they have earned.
