

Nixa Public Schools Logo & Trademark Guidelines

On March 12, 2009, the Board of Education approved a corporate logo to be used for academic and non-athletic activities.

And on June 10, 2010, the Board of Education approved a separate athletic logo to be used only for athletic activities.

Corporate/Academic Eagle

2 versions: full logo and eagle head only

Both are Federally registered trademarks

and should be used with the ® symbol when printing or publishing.

Appropriate Use

The corporate/academic eagle should be used for the following: school names, departments, school/department letterhead, official school business, school shirts, school marquees/signs, school vehicles (that are not for athletic use), academic (non-athletic) clubs and activities

The corporate/academic eagle should NOT be used for the following: athletic teams, athletic signage (unless used to show it is a district sign), athletic letterhead & athletic marquees.

Official Color



When printing, the red should be PMS 185. This may be substituted for PMS 186 if needed.

Gray or white may be used in the logo or as the full color of the logo or a combination, thereof. Grays can vary based on what is being printed.

Black should NEVER be used unless the logo is being printed in black & white or grayscale.

Official Font

Official font for logo, letterhead, and school signage/marquees: Myriad Pro

Avoiding Black

Black should NEVER be used for shirts or merchandise. Exceptions would be for a school theme.

Polos, shirts, and other official merchandise should be red, gray, or white with no black used. Charcoal gray is a good substitution for black.

Athletic Eagle

The athletic eagle is a Federally registered trademark and should be used with the ® symbol when printing or publishing.



Appropriate Use

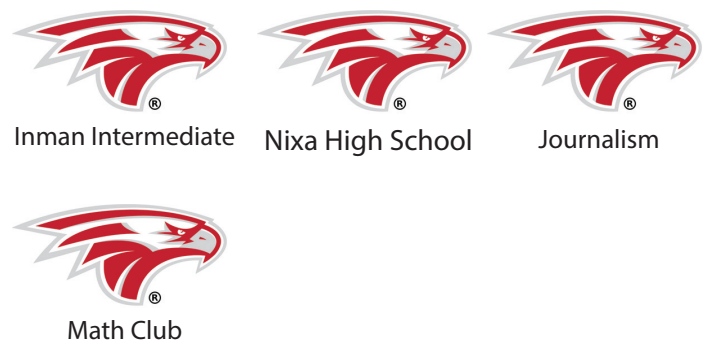
The athletic eagle should be used for the following: athletic teams, athletic signage (unless used to show it is a district sign), athletic letterhead, athletic marquees, or for spirit wear designed to support athletic teams.

The athletic eagle should NOT be used for the following: school names, departments, school/department letterhead, official school business, school shirts, school marquees/signs, school vehicles (that are not for athletic use), academic (non-athletic) clubs and activities.

Exceptions: The above guidelines and examples may be altered for athletic logo use if the product is being used for spirit wear. Example: High Pointe Elementary prints Nixa Eagle shirts for their students to wear for athletic events. If questions arise on exceptions, please contact Zac Rantz for clarification.

Official Color



When printing, the red should be PMS 185. This may be substituted for PMS 186 if needed.

Gray or white may be used in the logo. Grays can vary based on what is being printed.

Black should never be used unless the logo is being printed in black & white or grayscale.

Avoiding Black

Black should never be used for shirts or merchandise. Exceptions would be for a school theme.

Polos, shirts, and other official merchandise should be red, gray, or white.
