



ASQ CHECKLIST

Every child is unique, and you can help us learn about your child's unique strengths as they start Kindergarten with us next year. At in-person enrollment, you will complete two Ages & Stages Questionnaires; the ASQ-3 and the ASQ SE. These developmental screening tools will be used to help teachers provide more personalized support to children. The Kansas State Department of Education (KSDE) expects that all incoming Kindergarten students have this completed through the school's link before they begin learning.

Below are some items to review with your student before starting the ASQ questions. You can also use these as a guide for things to work with your young learner on between now and August.

- Can your child catch a small ball?
- Can your child cut with (child safe) scissors?
- Can your child tell about a story ?
- Can your child take turns while playing a board game?
- Can your child trace letters?
- Can your child draw pictures?
- Can your child write their first name?
- Can your child run?
- Can your child jump?
- Can your child hop?
- Can your child walk backwards?
- Can your child make a pattern?
- Does your child know their left from their right?
- Does your child know at least 5 letter sounds?
- Can your child rhyme? (my/pie) (play/say)
- Can your child zip their jacket?
- Can your child snap their pants?
- Can your child fold a piece of paper?
- Does your child use at least 5 words to show where things are?
- Does your child use the toilet by himself?
- Does your child do most of the bath time routine by herself?
- Does your child ask before using other people's things?
