- 10. Playground Committee Update, Chantal Hoffsten, Amelia Klueter
 - a. Chantal and Amelia discussed the rationale for the playground project including replacing the worn playground structure and building an inclusive playground. Hudson has traditionally been inclusive to students but our playground does not reflect that inclusivity. In fall 2018, a memorandum of understanding was entered into with Unlimited Play because of their expertise in playground development and in grant collaboration/fundraising. The committee is applying for a municipal park grant with Rock Hill as a cosponsor and Webster Groves School District as the other cosponsor. The grant covers approximately \$300,000 and the Hudson Playground Committee is responsible for fundraising at least 5% of the total playground cost. The current budget for the playground design is \$318,719.13. The playground design has been modified from the original options to be more cost-conscious. The surfacing chosen will be interlocking rubber tile since the tiles pop out for replacement purposes and this is less expensive than poured surfacing. The playground equipment vendor is Little Tikes. Inclusive playground features include a roller slide, disk swing, flushmounted merry go round, imaginative play features on the first level of the main play structure, and ramp access to the playground. Future steps needed for the playground to move forward include approval by both Rock Hill and the Webster Groves School District, fundraising of the matching funds, and successful application for the municipal grant.
