Chapter 37

- 37.001 requires the board of trustees of an independent school district to adopt a student code of conduct.
- Stakeholders included in the process are students, parents, staff, and community members



TIMELINE



NOVEMBER

Feedback Forms made available to all stakeholders via campus and district websites.



DECEMBER

DEIC presentation and seek feedback regarding possible revisions to the Code of Conduct and Student Handbook.



FEBRUARY-MAY

District Code of Conduct/Student Handbook Committee meet to discuss and reach consensus on possible revisions to the Code and Handbook.



MARCH-JULY

Provide assigned portions of the Student Code of Conduct/ Student Handbook to district level departments for review and suggested revisions.



AUGUST

Final draft of Code of Conduct will be presented to the CFISD Board of Trustees for final approval.
