



CIS SCHOOL UNIFORM INFORMATION

Last Update: January 2024

Each CIS student (except Pre-K2) is required to wear a uniform. Uniforms help create a comfortable and focused learning environment and help identify students as part of our school community.

Pre-K3 and Pre-K4 Uniform Requirements

All Early Childhood students are required to wear a hat (when outdoors) and closed toe shoes.

2023-2024 School Year:

- Short sleeve performance polo shirt with CIS logo
 - White or Cobalt blue
 - Interlock or rapid dry
- Bottoms: Khaki shorts, pants, skirt, or skorts

2024-2025 School Year:

The uniform will be changing to the PE Kit this academic year. This will be a transition year, so students will be allowed to wear the uniform specified above, but can also wear the PE Kit as listed below:

- PE Kit:
 - Short Sleeve T-shirt in Gray Heather color with CIS logo
 - Gym Shorts in Cobalt Blue

2025-2026 School Year:

All students will be required to wear the PE Kit.

Elementary School, Middle School, and High School Uniform Requirements

Tops

- Short sleeve performance polo shirt with CIS logo
 - White or Cobalt blue
 - Interlock or rapid dry
- Pinpoint (Oxford) Dress Shirt with CIS logo (not necessary in Elementary School)
 - French Blue color
- Long Sleeve with CIS logo (if preferred, but not required)
 - White or cobalt blue

Bottoms:

- Khaki shorts, pants, skirt, or skorts

PE Kit

- Short Sleeve T-shirt in Gray Heather color with CIS logo
- Gym Shorts in Cobalt Blue

Sweatshirts

- Classic Navy or blue color

Hats

- All students from Pre-K2 to Grade 5 are required to wear a hat when outdoors
- Students may wear CIS hats or other hats

Shoes

- Comfortable, closed toe (No color requirements)

Socks

- Comfortable (No color requirements)



Additional Guidelines

- Pinpoint (Oxford) shirts must always be tucked with buttons done up.
- Skirts and skorts must be mid-thigh or longer.
- Uniforms should be clean with no holes, missing buttons, tears, or frayed areas.
- Students are to remain in the school uniform for the entire school day.
- Students not in uniform will be sent home to change or loaned alternative clothing for the day.
- Uniforms should not be altered to suit individual styles or preferences.
- Underwear must not be visible at any time.
- Continued disrespect of the uniform policy/dress code may result in further consequences.
- While not required, secondary students are highly encouraged to wear school hats when outdoors.

Uniforms for Specific Events

Certain events may specify one or the other colored short-sleeve polo shirt so ensure you have at least one of each color.

School Photos, Concerts and Performances

- Pre-K2
 - No uniform
- Pre-K3 - Pre-K4
 - School Uniform (refer to page 1) unless specified otherwise.
- Kindergarten to Grade 5
 - Cobalt Blue Polo Shirt
 - Khaki Bottoms
- Grade 6 to 12
 - French Blue Pinpoint (Oxford) Dress Shirt with CIS logo
 - Khaki bottoms

Athletic and Learning Trips

- Team uniform, or
- PE shirt and shorts (unless otherwise specified)

Civvies Days

- Civvies days are the last Friday of each month
- On Civvies Days students do not have to wear their uniforms
- Students are encouraged to donate \$2 in support of local charities
- Clothes choices should be sensible and non-offensive.
