Cypress Ridge High School Homecoming Dance Dress Code for Students and Guests (Include Guest Form)

Why do we have a Dress Code?

The Cypress Ridge High School Administration wants you to make good choices. Homecoming should be fun and memorable, but we also want everyone to be appropriately dressed, safe, and show Ram PRIDE.

With modesty and safety in mind, the following dress code guidelines will be enforced at the Cypress Ridge High School Homecoming Dance. Failure to adhere to the dress code standards will prevent your entry into to the Dance.

Girls Dress Code (for Cy Ridge students and guests):

- 1. Dresses may not be cut below the bust line. Excessive cleavage is not allowed.
- 2. Dress may be backless as long as it is not cut below the navel.
- 3. Midriffs may not be exposed. This includes both the front and sides of the dress.
- 4. Dress length must be 5" from the middle of the knee ALL THE WAY AROUND as it lays.
- 5. Dresses must not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh (5 inches from mid knee).
- 6. Dresses with any sheer or see thru fabric, whatever is underneath must meet dress code guidelines.
- 7. After entry, altering apparel that violates the dress code will result in removal from the dance.

Boys Dress Code (for Cy Ridge students and guests)

1. Canes will not be permitted in the Dance.
